#### 1. OLIVER ZETER 'PERLAGE' SPARKLING SAUVIGNON BLANC

(Germany)

£21.99

Now here is something you don't see every day! This sensational Sauvignon Blanc from the Pfalz region is a seriously quaffable fizz, with elegant fruit flavours and a long, crisp finish. This brilliant Brut is made in the same 'Traditional Method' as Champagne, and works brilliantly as an aperitif.

#### 2. PRA 'OTTO' SOAVE (Italy)

£13.99

If you like your whites crisp and dry, then look no further than this beauty from Northern Italy. We like to think about this wine as 'Pinot Grigio with a personality' - boasting pear and honeysuckle aromas. The fruit character is balanced by a delicate almond flavour and a crisp, mineral finish. It's the perfect party white.

#### 3. DEOBRIGA RIOJA BLANCO (Spain)

£13.50

A Cork of the North exclusive, this white Rioja is complex and intriguing. Whilst packed with flavour, this white is velvety and fresh, and has an intensely fruity aftertaste with hints of vanilla. It's a party in your mouth, make no mistake.

#### 4. QUINTA DA BADULA ROSE (Portugal)

£11.99

Imported exclusively by Cork of the North, this beautiful rosé is nice and dry, but is packed with red-fruit flavours. From the Tejo region of Portugal, this is a rose to be enjoyed all year-round, not just in summer. This wine works very well with fish and white meats... but is perfect just on its own!



#### 5. 'THE FAKIR' GRENACHE (Australia)

£14.9

From the famous Magpie Estate in the Barossa Valley, 'The Fakir' is a fantastic fruity red with blackberry, blackcurrant and dried spice flavours. A little hint of leather and oak gives "The Fakir' a lovely savoury quality, and it is extremely food-friendly. "The Fakir' is one of our staff's firm favourites.

#### 8. YALUMBA 'THE CIGAR' CABERNET SAUVIGNON (Australia) £24.99

This delicious Coonawarra Cabernet has bright and fresh red fruit flavours, with cherries and currants sweeping the palate, followed by an exquisite melted chocolate texture. Seriously good stuff.



#### 9. FELINES JOURDAN PICPOUL DE PINET (France)

£12.50

Picpoul de Pinet is one of the best-value whites from the south of France. Full-flavoured, yet dry with a crisp freshness and citrus and herb flavour, this can be enjoyed on its own or with seafood. This is a five-star favourite and at this price, it's an absolute steal.

#### 10. LA SOUFRANDISE POUILLY FUISSE (France)

This wonderful white Burgundy is both gentle and generous. Made from old-vine Chardonnay, the winemakers have held back on the oak, allowing the rich fruit to come to the fore. It has a buttery, creamy mouthfeel, with a long, musky aftertaste. Outstanding quality.



## 11. THE MERCHANTS RANGE SAUVIGNON BLANC (New Zealand)

This magnificent Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is tremendous value for such high quality. Fresh and fruity, with all the trademark gooseberry and passion fruit flavours, this is a delicious white with verve and vibrancy.

12. BERRY BROS. SANCERRE (France)

This French classic is a wine of real quality and character. Made from Sauvignon Blanc, this has vibrant citrus aromas, which lead on to a complex blend of lemon, nettle and tropical fruit flavours. This really is 'class in a glass'.

## 13. DOMAINE PRUDHON 'LES ROUGES GORGES' ST AUBIN 2014 (France)

£25.99

This is one of the best Burgundies we have tasted in a long while. Medium-bodied, this fantastic Pinot Noir is more elegant than Joanna Lumley wearing a pearl necklace.

Despite its bottle-age, this high quality Premier Cru wine is still fabulously fruity and is remarkably good value at this price.

14. DOMAINE LA SEMELLERIE CHINON (France) £12.99

What's Loire got to do, got to do with it? Well, you can see the quality of this region's wines with this perfect example. Made from Cabernet Franc, this has the trademark leafy, green peppercorn aromas, and is soft, smooth and incredibly easy to drink. Light as a feather, but with a beautiful fruity punch... like an iron fist in a silk glove!

15. CONSTANTA GLEN THREE (South Africa) £21.50

A blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, this is full-bodied and powerful, but remains very elegant. Savoury dark and red fruit flavours are on show here, offering a long, lingering fruity aftertaste. This is drinking wonderfully now, but its structure means that it will develop admirably if cellared for another 10 years... if you can keep your hands off it for that long.

16. LA FLOR MALBEC (Argentina) £14.99

This Malbec is full-bodied and rich, with dark fruit flavours and the classic layers of black pepper, nutmeg and spice. Deliciously juicy... and as smooth as Bryan Ferry chatting up a supermodel.

This is a multi-award winning pink Champagne - clean and fresh, with lively red fruit flavours. Lallier is a small family winery making Pinot Noir-dominated blends from Grand Cru sites around Ay (also home to Bollinger, but Lallier's cellars are older!).

18. VILA NOVA VINHO VERDE (Portugal)

£9.99

This award-winning white is made by a good friend of ours - the brilliant and bonkers, Bernardo Lencastre. This is a vibrant, zingy and fresh Vinho Verde with the traditional light spritz - and has been one of Cork of the North's biggest selling wines this year. Wonderfully refreshing, and incredibly easy to drink!

19. LA LEYENDA 'LAS CRUCES' SAUVIGNON BLANC (Chile) £10.50

Just in case you needed yet another reminder that brilliant Sauvignon Blanc doesn't just come from New Zealand, here is a fruity little mix that will tantalise your taste-buds. Mouth-watering and moreish, this great value white is zesty on the palate with citrus and stone-fruit flavours.

20. TABALI PEDREGOSO VIOGNIER (Chile)

£10.99

This is Viognier at its aromatic best - give your glass a swirl and enjoy the aromas of citrus, orange peel, apricot, pears and peaches... This wine delivers on the palate as well as the nose, with floral, honey and citrus flavours. This wine is a good match for rich seafood and Thai cuisine. Try with seabass and ginger and you'll think you have died and gone to heaven.

Now let's be 'Frank' - pound for pound, this is one of the best value reds at Cork of the North. Soft, supple and with more drinkability than a glass of iced water in the Sahara desert, this is a smooth, medium-bodied wine with blackberry, plum and cherry flavours. This is a food-friendly wine that is fantastic with tomato-based dishes.

22. RASTEAU 'LES BANQUETTES ESCARPEES' (France)

We call this wine 'Chateauneuf's little brother'. Like the famous Rhône red, this Rasteau is robust and silky smooth - boasting rich, dark fruit flavours. Not only is this wine a perfect match for any Sunday roast, but it is equally as delicious on its own and is every bit as satisfying as a Chateauneuf-du-Pape - but at half the price!

23. TABALI TALUD CABERNET SAUVIGNON (Chile) £16.99

Here is the quintessential 'fireside red' - a fruity and full-bodied blockbuster from the Maipo Valley. This is rich and rewarding - with aromas of black Fruit Pastels and a terrific taste of blackcurrant and black cherries. This is a wonderful example of Cabernet Sauvignon, and is a real customer favourite.

24. DOMAINE GRANGES-NEUVE MONBAZILLAC (France)

A fabulous dessert wine - this sweet and fruity concoction is simply orange marmalade in a glass. There are also delicious flavours of melon, nectarine, honey and toffee to enjoy here. Monbazillac is delicious with desserts, but is equally at home with a quality pâté or with soft blue cheeses like Roquefort.

£39.99

Is English fizz as good as Champagne? Taste for yourself! The Nyetimber Classic Cuvee is made in the same way as Champagne, using similar grape varieties and production techniques. The result is creamy and rich, with a refreshing zesty tang. Available in special gift boxes.

26. A-MANO BIANCO (Italy)

£11.99

Crisp, clean and refreshing, with white peach and grapefruit flavours, this is complex and zesty. This is one of those wines which just makes people smile – you can really taste the sunny Italian south in this blend of Fiano, Falanghina and Greco.

## 27. GREYWACKE MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC (New Zealand)

£18.99

This famous wine is made by the legendary Kevin Judd, who was the winemaker at Cloudy Bay. This fresh 2017 vintage is one of the finest of his wines we have tasted – opulently perfumed with passionfruit and gooseberry. This high-quality white is several notches above the usual Marlborough Sauvignons, and is worth every penny.



28. FRAMINGHAM CLASSIC RIESLING (New Zealand)

£14.99

It isn't often we taste a wine that really surprises us, but this remarkable Riesling – from Marlborough – has blown us away. Rich and seductive, this is fabulously fruity and slightly 'off-dry'. There is a full spectrum of complex flavours here, with tangy fruit and a soft texture. A real crowd pleaser!

#### 29. FRAMINGHAM PINOT NOIR (New Zealand)

£19.99

Are you having roast turkey, duck or lamb on Christmas Day? WELL THIS IS THE WINE THAT WE RECOMMEND TO GO WITH YOUR FESTIVE FEAST! Boasting silky tannins and a heavenly fragrance, this Pinot Noir has a smoky, savoury, spicy character to match the classic cranberry, and plum flavours. It's like drinking liquid velvet.

## 32. DANDELION 'LIONHEART OF THE BAROSSA' SHIRAZ (Australia)

E14.99

Fantastically full-bodied, this is as fruity as Sid James's laugh. A real Aussie blockbuster, boasting the heady flavours of sweet blackberry, raspberry, plums and dark chocolate – with lashings of sweet spice. A real winter warmer, make no mistake.

#### 33. DRAPPIER 'CARTE D'OR CHAMPAGNE (France)

£38.99

This is our favourite Champagne. Made from a blend that is mostly Pinot Noir, the Carte d'Or has a unique and distinctive 'red fruit' character. French president Charles de Gaulle liked this Champagne so much, he bought a house right next to the vineyard. Cork of the North owner Marc Hough would love to do the same, but sadly he can't afford it!

#### 34. SCREAMING BETTY VERMENTINO (Australia)

£15.50

Vermentino is a grape that hails from the Italian island of Sardinia, but the Aussies are now growing these vines and they've absolutely nailed it! This is a wonderfully crisp and fresh white wine which is vibrant and aromatic, with light citrus flavours.

#### 35. ADOBE RESERVA CHARDONNAY (Chile)

£8.50

Now here is a wine that seriously punches above its weight! This organic white is fresh and nutty, with subtle tropical fruit aromas. It has a velvety texture and has a persistent and enjoyable aftertaste. Ideal as an aperitif, with seafood, or even a good cheeseboard. Outstanding value.

36. QUINTA DA BADULA RESERVA BRANCA (Portugal) £11.99

Exclusively imported by Cork of the North, this white really stands out from the crowd. Aromas of white fruits fill your nose, then the scent of sweet vanilla tickles your senses. But then the taste! WOW! It's elegant and complex at the same time, with pear, honey, and toffee apple flavours. Powerful, with a well-judged hint of oak. Downright gorgeous.



37. RENATO RATTI 'OCHETTI' LANGHE NEBBIOLO (Italy)

Ratti is among the finest producers in Italy's Piedmont region, which is most famous for Barolo. The Langhe is a sub-region outside the Barolo districts, but its grape is the same: nebbiolo. Ratti's Orchetti nebbiolo is easy on the wallet; it will cost you a third of the price of a top Barolo, but it will give you nearly as much satisfaction.

40. 'THE TIGHT CLUSTER' SPARKLING SHIRAZ (Australia)

As you pour this tasty Barossa beauty into your glass, you're instantly captivated by the rich red nectar with fine spiralling bubbles. When the delicate bubbles hit your tongue, soft cracked black pepper mingled with cloves and star anise burst forth. Fruit driven, this delicious wine is soft with nuances of raspberry jam and is FABULOUS with Christmas food – served hot or cold.

#### 41. DOMAINE BOTTI SAINT VERAN (France)

£16.99

It's not often you can get a decent white Burgundy for this price, so snap up a few bottles before it's gone! This Saint-Veran is crisp, elegant and floral. It's very delicate, with fresh citrus aromas and is slightly creamy on the palate. Perfect with seafood or a nice salad.

#### 42. FEUDI DI SAN GREGORIO ALBENTE FALANGHINA (Italy) £11.50

This wonderful white from southern Italy has intense aromas of delicate white flowers and fruit, with great balance and a clean finish. This wine is ideal as an aperitif, but is also extremely food friendly and will pair well with simple fish or vegetable dishes.



#### 43. KTIMA GEROVASSILIOU (Greece)

£17.50

It may be difficult to pronounce, but this wine is incredibly easy to drink – and is widely regarded as one of the best wines produced in Greece. A blend of two indigenous grape varieties, Malagousia and Assyrtiko, this wine is extremely aromatic, and has a pleasant lemony tang. Brilliant.



#### 44. TIKVES KRATOSIJA (Macedonia)

£8.99

Now here is an uncomplicated, party red... from Macedonia! This great value wine is light bodied, but has a lovely texture with vibrant redcurrant fruit flavours. The Kratosija grape (pronounced Krat-oss-SHEE-yah), has the same genetic origins as the Italian Primitivo variety.



45. RONCEL DO SIL 'VEL'UVERYA' MENCIA (Spain)

£14.99

This is a light, but fruity Spanish red with zingy, lifted red fruit flavours. The grape is Mencia, and the Ronsel Do Sil vineyards are in Ribeira Sacra, in Galicia.
